Following are a few health and safety guidelines for shoppers along with measures La Palmera is taking to help curb the spread of germs and viruses.

- It is always recommended those with a fever, or cold and flu-like symptoms such as a cough, sore throat, runny nose or body aches, should stay home.
- Be mindful of your proximity to other shoppers and maintain the recommended 6-foot distance from others whenever possible.
- All guests over the age of 10 are always **REQUIRED** to wear a face mask or covering over his/her nose and mouth, including in all common areas, retailers and restaurants.
- Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands.
- If you sneeze without a face mask, please cover your nose and mouth with a tissue and place it in the garbage. Follow by washing your hands or using hand sanitizer.
- Freestanding alcohol-based hand sanitizer dispensers in place at all mall entrances.
- Restrooms are located throughout the mall where you can wash your hands thoroughly for a minimum of 20 seconds with soap and water.
- Our housekeeping staff is cleaning restrooms more frequently than usual, making sure soap dispensers are full, surfaces are wiped down and the garbage bins are emptied more often.
- Although stores and restaurants are being mindful of health requirements and guidelines, if an individual shop or eatery feels too busy for your own comfort level, we invite you stop back by at a later time.
- We continue to utilize stepped-up cleaning and hygiene practices, including the use of CDC-approved cleaning supplies throughout the mall.
- Cleaning and disinfecting areas most susceptible to the spread of viral germs is a top priority, including our restrooms, door handles, escalator handrails, and other areas the public commonly touches.
